School Book Rental Scheme for Senior Cycle students 2024 (5th and 6th year students)

Terms and conditions of scheme

The scheme is voluntary. Book lists will be supplied to parents in the normal way (on the school website killinaschool.ie) for parents who wish to remain outside of the book rental scheme.

An annual rental charge of €120 per year will apply.

Purchase of workbooks, disposable materials and stationery will remain outside the scope of this scheme and remain the responsibility of the parents.

To qualify for admission to the scheme, the rental charge must be paid before the end of June.

Each pupil and parent are responsible for the books supplied. A record of books loaned to a student is kept by the school. If books are lost or damaged full compensation/ replacement for these books will be required before re-admission to the scheme.

The books supplied under the scheme will remain the property of the school and may be subject to inspection at any time by a member of the teaching staff.

Membership of the scheme is at the discretion of the board of management and the school principal. Any pupil found to be abusing, defacing or disposing of rented books will be dismissed from the scheme and will be required to supply their own textbooks for the remainder of their time in the school.

Books supplied under the scheme may be new or second hand at the discretion of the principal and board of management.

If you wish to partake in the scheme, then the rules as set out are deemed as accepted on payment of the rental fee.

Books will only be provided to students where payment has been made to the scheme in advance.
