Homework Policy

Policy Statement:

It is the policy of Killina Presentation Secondary School:

- That each student be assigned homework daily.
- That homework should be undertaken to the best of each student's ability.
- That homework tasks should be set to the ability of the students.

Rationale:

Homework is assigned in accordance with the mission statement of the school to develop a work ethic and self-discipline which will enable students to reach their full potential. Homework is assigned for the following reasons:

- To help the student to become an effective learner.
- To enable the student to master life skills and concepts as recommended in the curriculum.
- To involve parents/guardians in their children's educational development.
- To provide important, regular feedback for teachers.

Homework Composition:

Homework will generally be comprised of the following:

- (1) Written work
- (2) Reading and learning of material
- (3) Research
- (4) Revision of material already covered

Note:

Reading, learning and revision of material is essential for and of equal importance to the written element of homework.

The Teacher:

- The teacher will assign homework and the homework will be noted accurately by the student in his/her journal.
- The teacher will correct homework and provide meaningful feedback to students.
- The teacher will monitor the homework of each individual student.

The Student:

- Each student must have the Killina Presentation Secondary School Journal for recording homework and for the purpose of liaison between home and school.
- The student will note all homework assigned be it written, reading, learning, research or revision in their student journal.
- Homework should be completed to the best of the student's ability.
- It is the responsibility of the student to ensure he/she is aware of work that needs to be completed when absent from class.

Parent(s)/ Guardian (s):

- (1) Parent (s) / Guardian (s) will in so far as is practicable :
- Provide a suitable location, free from distraction, for the completion of homework.
- Regularly inspect the student journal.
- Ensure the student spends a reasonable amount of time at homework.
- Monitor the recording of homework in the student journal each night.
- (2) Suggested time to be spent on homework:

1<sup>st</sup> Years- 1.5 hours

2<sup>nd</sup> Years- 1.5-2 hours

3<sup>rd</sup> Years- 2-3 hours

5<sup>th</sup> Years - 2.5-3 hours

6<sup>th</sup> Years - 3 - max 5 hours (3.5/4 hours)
```

The School:

- The school recommends that homework take priority over other activities that the student may be engaged in, with particular emphasise on examination years.
- The school will endeavour to impart effective learning/study skills and techniques to students by organising a study skills seminar for first, third and sixth year students, where each student will receive a concise handout on study skills.
