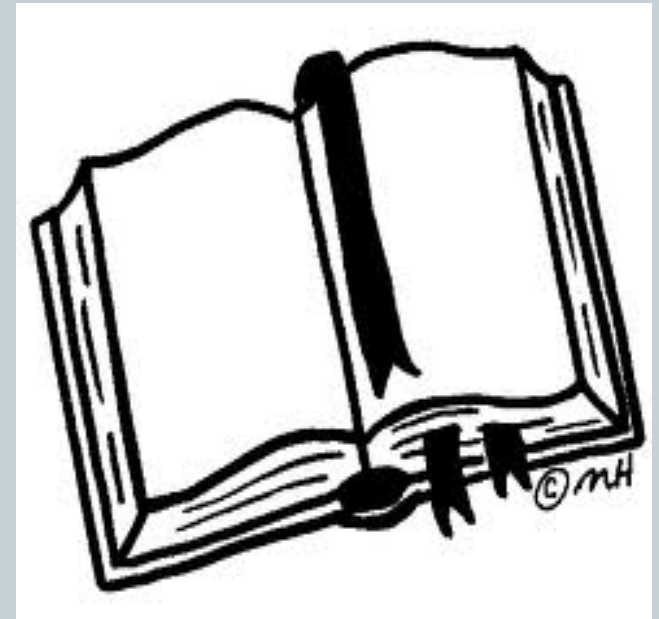

- Late enrolment forms will be marked as late and only considered after processing applications received before the deadline.
